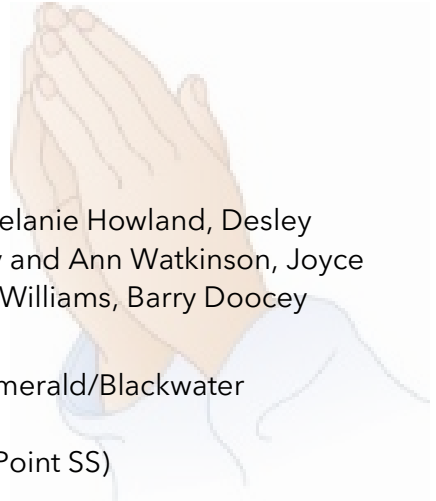

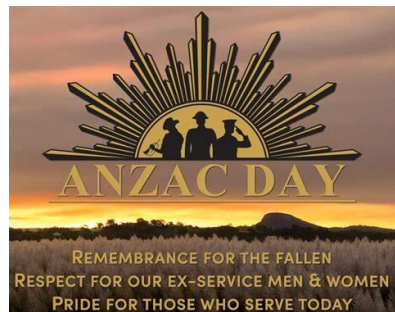

TELSTRA AND BIGPOND E-MAIL ISSUES

Telstra are blocking their customers from receiving e-mails from a number of organisations, including us. The fix they provided did not last so if you use a bigpond email address, you may not receive emails from our parish (*this does not include emails sent via Elvanto e.g. the Tidings email*).

Telstra have provided the following instructions for receivers of e-mails (those with bigpond email addresses) which may help.

1. Go here <http://email.telstra.com>
2. Log in
3. Go to **Settings** (top right next to logout)
4. Go to **Mail** (left hand menu)
5. Go to **Safe Senders** (just under where you clicked Mail)
6. Add **@anglicanchurchsq.org.au** as a safe sender.



If you choose to change your email address, please let the office know.
